**ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR EXPEDITED HEARING

1. Debtor's Motion For An Order Pursuant To 11 U.S.C. §§ 102 And 105(a) And Bankruptcy Rules 2002(m) And 9007 Establishing Omnibus Hearing Dates And Certain Notice, Case Management And Administrative Procedures;
2. Debtor's Motion For An Order Pursuant To 11 U.S.C. §§ 105 And 363 Authorizing Continued Use Of Existing Bank Accounts And Cash Management System, As Modified;
3. Debtor's Motion Pursuant To 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) And 363(b) For Authorization To Pay Pre-Petition Wages, Compensation, Employee Benefits;
4. Debtor's Motion Pursuant To 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a), 363(b) And (c), 507(a)(8), For Authorization To Pay Pre-Petition Business License Tax;
5. Debtor's Motion For Order Authorizing Retention Of Professionals Utilized By Debtor In Ordinary Course Of Business;
6. Debtor's Motion Pursuant To 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(a) And 363(b) And (c) For Authorization To Continue Debtor's Workers' Compensation Programs, All Other Insurance Policies, All Agreements Relating Thereto, And Pay All Obligations In Respect Thereof;
