Filing Requirements for Fact Summary Sheet

Updated 05/04/2020

Local Rule 4001(c) requires a *Fact Summary Sheet* to be filed with *Motions for Relief from the Automatic Stay* and applicable *Motions for Adequate Protection* submitted in chapter 7 and 13 cases in all Alabama Northern Bankruptcy divisions.

The Fact Summary **must** be filed along with Motions for Relief from Stay and/or Co-Debtor Stay, Motions to Renew a Relief from Stay, and Motions for Adequate Protection in chapter 7 and 13 cases;

The *Fact Summary* **must** substantially comply with the fact summary sheet form <u>*LR* 4001-1(c)</u> *Fact Summary Sheet for Motion for Relief from Automatic Stay or for Adequate Protection in* <u>*Chapter 7 and Chapter 13 Cases*</u> found on the Court's website under **Forms > Forms Referenced** in the Local Rules at: <u>https://www.alnb.uscourts.gov/forms/all-forms/localrules_forms</u>.

The *Fact Summary* **must** be completed in full and filed as a <u>separate</u> event at least 14 days prior to the first hearing date on the *Motion*;

The Fact Summary shall be filed using the Court's Electronic Case Filing ("ECF") System;

The *Fact Summary* shall be served by Movant's attorney using ECF (Debtor's attorney will receive an electronic notification of the filing of the *Summary*); and

The *Fact Summary* must **<u>NOT</u>** be filed as an <u>attachment</u> to the *Motion*.

To file the *Fact Summary*, select menu **Bankruptcy** > **Miscellaneous** > **Fact Summary for Motion for Relief from Stay** and attach *.pdf of *Fact Summary*.

If the movant does not fully complete, timely file, and properly serve the *Fact Summary*, the Court may continue, dismiss, or deny the *Motion*.
